He is the recipient of playwriting grants from CBS, the Rockefeller and the Guggenheim Foundations; a Tony Award nomination for A History of the American Film, Obie Awards for Sister Mary Ignatius and The Marriage of Bette and Boo...and a Drama Desk nomination for acting.


