

Director's Notes

A playground altercation between eleven-year-old boys brings together two sets of Brooklyn parents for a meeting to resolve the matter. At first, diplomatic niceties are observed, but as the meeting progresses, and the rum flows, tensions emerge and the gloves come off, leaving the couples with more than just their liberal principles in tatters. Yasmina Reza's *God of Carnage* brings these parents back to the infantile playground quarrels and animal instincts that sometimes still reside in us all, especially in defense of our children. This dark comedy reminds us that we are more than we appear to be on the surface. The chaos and conflict of the world brought on by the god of carnage affects virtue and goodness down to the smallest scale - such as even a simple meeting to resolve a children's playground fight.
